## TEMPORARY CLOSURE NOTICE

At an extraordinary meeting of Felbrigg Village Hall Trustees on Monday 10th February 2025 it was decided to temporarily close the village hall while essential maintenance and health and safety upgrades and refurbishments are started. It has been a difficult time for the trustees to come to this decision.

A detailed building survey, fire and electrical inspections were carried out on the hall in the latter months of last year and we have been advised of essential works that must be carried out. Because of these requirements, it is with regret that we have to suspend all activities and close the doors for a period of time.

Our sincere apologies to anyone who has made enquiries to book the village hall during March, April and the rest of the year. This isn't something we had planned to do but unfortunately with all the Health & Safety conditions and regulations that we have to comply with today, we cannot stay open for any hirings while works are going on.

Because of the future disruption, everything will be put on hold until we are able to re-open, including our monthly Community Café's and associated events. Over the last year the trustees have tried very hard to run a variety of monthly events to bring the community of Felbrigg and Metton and surrounding villages together on a regular basis. These events have been fabulous and well attended. They have brought people together and have helped us raise some money to pay the village hall regular costs and upkeep, but it has been a lot of work.

A considerable amount of effort has been put into organising and running the events we have held and also commitment from both our trustees and volunteers. We are especially grateful to anyone who has volunteered, helped or done anything for the village hall in the past.

A variety of different reasons have led to trustee resignations and we are now in need of more people to help run our lovely community space. The village hall relies on its trustees to look after it well for the future residents of Felbrigg and Metton. The trustees are responsible to carry out the requirements of both the Charity Commission and the Conveyancing Deed from when the village hall was donated to the village in 1973.

If you or somebody you know would like to be involved and find out more about becoming a trustee or volunteer, we would love to have a chat with you. Without more people it will be a struggle to carry on with events.
